Paul, a slave of <u>Christ Jesus</u> called as <u>an apostle</u> and singled out for <u>God's good news</u> – ² which <u>He promised</u> long ago through <u>His prophets in</u> <u>the Holy Scriptures</u> – ³ concerning <u>His Son, Jesus Christ our Lord</u>, who <u>was</u> <u>a descendant of David</u> according to the flesh ⁴ and who has been declared to be the <u>powerful Son of God</u> by the <u>resurrection from the dead</u> according to the <u>Spirit of holiness</u>. ⁵ We have received grace and <u>apostleship</u> through <u>Him</u> to bring about the <u>obedience of faith</u> among <u>all the nations</u>, on behalf of <u>His name</u>, ⁶ including yourselves who also belong to <u>Jesus Christ</u> by calling: ⁷ To all who are in Rome, loved by <u>God</u> called as saints. Grace to you and peace from <u>God our Father</u> and the <u>Lord Jesus Christ</u>.

⁸First, I thank my <u>God</u> through <u>Jesus Christ</u> or all of you because the news of <u>your faith</u> is being reported in <u>all the world</u>.⁹For God whom I serve with my spirit in telling the <u>good news</u> about <u>His Son</u> is my witness that I constantly mention you, ¹⁰ always asking in my prayers that if it is somehow in <u>God's</u> will, I may now at last succeed in coming to you. ¹¹For I want very much to see you, so I may impart to you some spiritual gift to strengthen you, ¹² that is, to be mutually encouraged <u>each other's faith</u> both <u>yours and mine</u>.¹³Now I want you to know, brothers, that I often planned to come to you (but was prevented until now) in order that I might have a fruitful ministry among you, just as among the rest of the <u>Gentiles</u>¹⁴I am obligated both <u>to Greeks and</u> <u>barbarians</u> both to the <u>wise and the foolish</u>¹⁵So I am eager to preach good news to you also who are in Rome.

¹⁶ For I am not ashamed of <u>the gospel</u> because <u>it</u> is <u>God's power for</u> <u>salvation</u> to <u>everyone who believes</u> <u>first to the Jew</u> and <u>also to the</u> <u>Greek</u>. ¹⁷ For <u>it God's righteousness</u> is revealed from <u>faith to faith just as</u> <u>it is written</u>: The <u>righteous</u> will live by <u>faith</u>.

I am proud of <u>the gospel</u> because <u>it</u> demonstrates:

- <u>God's miraculous ability to save all who believe, according</u> to <u>His promises.</u>
- <u>God's</u> own <u>righteousness</u> & how <u>He</u> remains <u>righteous</u> <u>while</u> <u>making the unrighteous righteous</u>
- Those whom <u>God makes righteous live (forever) by faith</u>
